

I have been given, and embraced, leadership opportunities, my children are happy Gippsland Grammar students, and our weekends are filled with surfing, bike riding and exploring."





WHY LIVE IN GIPPSLAND?




Gippsland Grammar's campuses at Sale and Bairnsdale are located in the heart of Gippsland in Victoria, which is one of Australia's most diverse and picturesque regions.

Stretching from the eastern outskirts of Melbourne to the New South Wales border, Gippsland's vast landscape offers endless opportunities for exploration including the rugged 90 Mile Beach, the snow-capped High Country, the tranquil Gippsland Lakes and the untouched Wilson's Promontory

National Park. 
